Established in 2022 by Aga and Vincenzo Della Pietra, Dom Restaurant & Bar in Thurlaston offers a culinary blend of locally-sourced British ingredients with global influences. Vincenzo, born near Naples, brings his experience from Michelin-starred kitchens to create a menu rooted in hyper-seasonal produce and a zero-waste philosophy. Dom's dining style leans towards tapas, with a suggested six to eight dishes for two people. Customers can expect freshly cooked small plates, which pair well with an extensive selection of world wines. Notable dishes include the Spicy Chinese Pork Belly with honey sesame seeds, the Dom Slider featuring a homemade beef burger with chipotle mayo, Octopus carpaccio with heritage tomato and finger lime citronette, and Hoisin Duck Breast served with cornmeal taco. The restaurant also offers traditional Sunday roasts.
