

380th Anniversary Commemoration

In June 1645, Leicester faced the bloodiest 48 hours in its long history. Just 2,000 brave defenders, many of them civilians, stood against over 11,000 Royalist troops in a siege that changed the course of the English Civil War.

Highlights include the launch of the Green Room Gardener's new book, Dose of Dance sessions, Leicester Hospitals' Museum collection display, performances by Rob Gee, the Comedy Asylum and the Smoothie Collective. You can also enjoy live art, create your own body art, and perform poetry. Come relax, get inspired and explore the power of creativity!

Restore the Soar

Did you know the River Soar flows through the heart of Leicester? This beautiful and historically rich waterway plays a significant role in the city's landscape.

Restore the Soar is a National Lottery Heritage Fund project, led by Leicester City Council, Leicestershire & Rutland Wildlife Trust and the Canal & River Trust. It focuses on the river corridor from Frog Island to Watermead Country Park, aiming to reconnect people with this natural treasure.

Student Art Showcase

As part of the project, Leicester College Art students have responded to the theme 'Restoring the Soar' with creative works that celebrate the river's wildlife, heritage, and potential for renewal. See their artwork, paintings, textiles, ceramics, digital art and more on display along the riverside railings at the Riverside Festival. 
