





Explore Leicester's rich history at Newarke Houses, formed from two historic buildings dating back to 1511. Since 1953 the museum has bought together a collection of the things which make up people's everyday lives, including a collection of toys, a thought-provoking regimental collection and a recreated First World War trench. There is also a 1950s street scene where you can hear the stories of people who call Leicester their home.

Discover how Leicester's Victorians kept clean water flowing for the growing City with exhibitions that encourage all the family to get hands-on with the history of science, industry, transport, health and hygiene. The museum also charts the early days of motorised transport with a rare collection of vintage vehicles including buses, fire engines, a hansom cab and its own narrow-gauge railway, which can be seen on special events days.
